Nelson Lima is Full Professor of University of Minho and in 1993 he got his Ph.D. in Engineering Basic Sciences (Biotechnology) by University of Minho. Since 1996 he is head of Micoteca da Universidade do Minho (MUM), a fungi culture collection, www.micoteca.deb.uminho.pt. Currently he is member of the executive board of World Federation of Culture Collections (WFCC). He has been associated editor of Journal of Applied Microbiology, Letters in Applied Microbiology and Research Journal of Microbiology, and he is a frequente reviewer of more than other 20 international journals. He supervised 8 and 19 PhD and Master thesis, respectively and, currently he supervises 9 and 5 PhD and Master students respectively. He has more than 140 papers published (in SCOPUS 52 papers and index h = 15) and more than 200 scientific communications.


